Cat will advise about the current situation re getting the programme going.




The surgeons and doctors donate their time and skills, with the costs of theatre use and consumables along with the airfares and sundry costs are supplied by Romac.

Jay said he had met a heart surgeon who has supported heart surgery overseas and that this is an ongoing requirement.
