PRESIDENT'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Last week Quentin and Derek Atkinson attended a "Membership Roadshow" in Epsom presented by PG District 9640, Andy Rajapakse, Zone 8's New Style Club Specialist.



Andy is currently on a 14-day Roadshow conducting 14 workshops in 12 cities from Auckland to Dunedin and across all 5 Rotary Districts.

The Epsom workshop with Andy was well attended and we looked at how the various types of Rotary Clubs can lead to the growth that the Gold Coast has seen lately - **going from the worst performing district in Australia to being in the top 14 districts for growth in the world.**

Club types discussed were:

- **Special Cause Club** - when a club forms around a single activity, such as the sailing club on the North Shore
- **Satellite Club** - where a young club grows under the umbrella of the existing club. Eventually as the main club ages, the Satellite club can take over
- **Passport Club** - a club focused solely on community project either by themselves or with other organisations. The meetings are of minimal importance and may happen on social media over long distances.
