Ernie Meyer updated us on the successful installation of the last **Club Honours Board** in the Onehunga Community House.














5-minute Speaker

BILL GRAYSON Reminiscences of an Old Sailor

Bill delivered an incredibly persuasive presentation, drawing parallels between how technology has not only impacted the way boats are sailed, but also how it has negatively impacted the behaviour of our kids.

From heads-up to heads-down

Bill opened with a slide presentation of his early sailing experiences and the enjoyment of the simpler, non-stressful days of no modern technology. He pointed out that as yachts had no electronics on board, they had to be sailed using a "heads-up" approach.

As time progressed and technology crept in and helper gadgets began to change sailing to a more "heads-down" approach - which would occasionally lead to shipwrecks.

During his sailing adventures Bill conveyed the enjoyment to be found in open, personal relationships - even when there is a language barrier. He demonstrated this with a story of arriving on an isolated Pacific Island where he couldn't speak their language and they couldn't speak his, however the universal basics of social interaction were still applied, such as the sharing of food, drink and a meal.

Extending universal basics to all living creatures, Bill related how his rehabilitation of a rescue dog by applying love and attention, food and shelter, resulted in a happy and contented family pet.


The Anxious Generation

Bill then introduced how since 2010 kids have developed to be more "heads-down" and have become "the anxious generation".


He referenced this change to a recent article in the NZ Herald concerning the findings of research performed by **Dr Jonathan Haidt**, Social Psychologist and Professor at the NYU Stern School of Business.

Dr Haidt's research found a direct correlation between the sharp increase in youth anxiety problems (and self-harm and suicide attempts) which started in 2010 **when the combined use of smartphones and social media began overloading the lives of young people.**





Bill recommended a newly published (April, 2024) book by Dr Jonathan Haidt, titled: *The Anxious Generation: How the Great Rewiring of Childhood is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness.*



Dr Haidt says, "The book and the <u>website</u> (www.anxiousgeneration.com) are designed to facilitate discussion among friends, family, book clubs, and communities, in order to change norms and *reclaim* human life for all generations.

He noted that since around the 1980's there has been a gradual change in the behaviour of children which he attributes to two main factors:

1. **Decline of play-based childhood** since 1980's:

- a. Rise of continual adult supervision due to media-fed fear for child safety.
- b. Decline of child/child contact to develop relationships and shared adventures.
- c. Decline in learning how to judge risks for themselves.

2. Rise in phone-based childhood which began in the late 2000s:

- a. Increase in social media platforms since 2008.
- b. The increase in smart phones since the 2010s.
- c. Faster, cheaper internet access that enabled live video.

= Resulted in:

- 1. Over-protection of children in the real world
- 2. Under-protection of children in the virtual world.

Children nowadays often lack the "heads up" free-play necessary to wire their brains and prepare them for adulthood. Since the advent of smartphones and mobile technology around the 2010s, children have become more "heads down" and to a greater extent, anxiety filled.

So, what action can we take for our kids?

Adopt the following:
